

AIR POWER -- The U.S. Air Force's F-16 fighter airplane is shown with weaponry it can carry. Included are Sidewinder air-to-air missiles on the wingtips, several air-to-surface missiles, laser-guided munitions and laser target seekers, bombs of various sizes and other conventional ordnance. Forming a V in front is a belt of 20mm ammunition. The F-16 is designed as an air superiority plane for coproduction by North Atlantic Treaty Organization countries.
