THE SHAPE OF SPEED — The unconventional lines of the U.S. Air Force's SR-71 Blackbird are displayed in this aerial view (top) and head-on ground view. Developed by the Lockheed company of Burbank, California, the craft is specially designed to survey enemy forces and installations with cameras and other equipment. It can fly as high as 30,000 meters and has a speed of more than 3,200 kilometers-per-hour, making it one of the fastest planes in the world.
