BUNKER BLASTER -- A tomahawk cruise missile, armed with a conventional warhead, demonstrates its terminal dive mode of attack (top) and destroys a concrete and steel structure the size of a warehouse. The missile was launched from a submerged submarine off the coast of southern California and flew some 650 kilometers to the target. The terminal dive mode of attack allows for increased effectiveness against a wide range of targets, including those surrounded by man-made or natural obstacles.
