

SKY GIANT -- Crowds gather around the giant 747-400 -- the largest, longest
-range airliner in the world -- as it is unveiled at the Boeing aircraft plant
in Everett, Washington. The latest 747 derivative, which is distinguished by
its 1.8-meter (6 feet) wingtip extension and 1.8-meter-high winglets, is
designed to carry 412 passengers for up to 11,750 kilometers. Eighteen
customers have already ordered 118 of the aircraft. The Boeing company
unveiled the 737-400 twin-jet aircraft at it's Renton, Washington facility the
same day.
