'NEW AMERICAN REVOLUTION' -- President Nixon urges support for a "new American revolution" that will allow the United States to enter its third century "new in spirit, with all the vigor and freshness" of its beginnings. The annual State of the Union message was delivered before a Joint Session of the Congress at the Capitol in Washington on January 22. Also present were Cabinet members, Justices of the Supreme Court and representatives of the Diplomatic Corps. The 35-minute address was carried to the nation over television and radio. Mr. Nixon proposed a vast restructuring of government, a new sharing of national and local power and money, and broad new approaches to the problems of medical care and environment.
