

"Unless our allies are strong, the Kremlin might take them over, and the danger of war would increase," Harry S. Truman, President of the United States of America, declared recently at the sixth annual National Conference on Citizenship, held in Washington, D. C.

The President said the defense program in the United States has two parts -- "building up our own armed forces and our national strength . . . and helping our allies to build up their strength, so they can do their share in preventing war and stopping aggression."

The conference was sponsored by the United States National Education Association and the United States Department of Justice.
