The Columbus Memorial Fountain stands in front of the Union Station in Washington, D.C. Here two heroic-size figures representing the Old and New World flank a central shaft topped with a massive globe. From the base of the shaft emerges a ship's prow, bearing the figure of Columbus. The Fountain was designed by the distinguished sculptor Lorado Taft and was dedicated in 1912. Here the Washington, D.C., chapter of the Knights of Columbus hold their annual Columbus Day ceremony each October 12. (52-8172)

La fuente del monumento a Colón se alza frente a la Union Station de Washington, D.C.
