On October 5, 1951, a new flag approved and partly designed by U. S. General of the Army Dwight D. Eisenhower (right), was officially raised at Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE) near Paris, France. Representatives of different North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) countries are shown holding the flag prior to ceremonies. The motto imprinted on the flag in Latin is "Vigilance is the price of liberty." General Eisenhower was appointed first NATO Supreme Commander in December 1950.
