

PRINCETON -- A UNIVERSITY OF CREATIVE THOUGHT

Princeton University in Princeton, New Jersey, established in 1746, is one of the oldest universities in the United States. It is characterized by the concept of individualized education with a faculty of "teacher-scholars." Among the alumni of Princeton are two American Presidents, James Madison and Woodrow Wilson.

A research Stellarator is in operation in a laboratory at Princeton University, one of four main U.S. centers where research is being conducted to control thermonuclear reaction. The Stellarator, known as a "magnetic bottle," was developed to control fusion by confinement.
