REJUVENATED HALL -- The reopening of the world famous Carnegie Hall in New York City is celebrated with a gala concert. The Hall, built in 1891, was closed for a seven-month, \$50 million restoration headed by its president, violinist Isaac Stern. Among the improvements are an enlarged lobby, repainting of the main hall, new seats and elevators, and a modern air-conditioning system.
