Looking at University Hall through the Van Wickl~~e~~ Gates at Brown University. These gates are traditionally opened only twice a year: once in the fall when they open inward to receive the incoming freshmen and again in June when they open outward for the graduating seniors, who pass through on their way down College Hill to Commencement exercises at the First Baptist Meeting House.

University Hall, original "college edifice" of 1770, is one of seven college buildings in the United States built before the Revolution which are still standing. From 1776 to 1782 to was used as a barracks for French and American troops and as a hospital. Today it houses most of the University's administrative offices.
