Forty-nine exact replicas of the Liberty Bell were commissioned by the U.S. Treasury Department to be cast at the famous Paccard Foundry in Annecy-le-Vieux, Haute-Savoie, France, for use in the 1950 U.S. Savings Bond drive. Each State capital received one of these duplicate bells to be rung on July 4th, the anniversary of the adoption of the American Declaration of Independence.
