

OUTRAGE AT 'MASSACRE' -- President Ronald Reagan condemned the Soviet Union for the downing of Korean Air Lines flight 007 in a nationally-televised address from the White House in Washington. He termed the attack by a missile-firing Soviet airplane as a "massacre of 269 innocent men, women and children aboard an unarmed Korean passenger plane," and said: "This crime against humanity must never be forgotten, here or throughout the world."
