

X-RAY EXCHANGE -- An Eastman Kodak Company engineer in Rochester (New York) demonstrates how an X-ray image can be transmitted over telephone lines to a medical office many miles away using a Kodak Ektascan image transmission system. The photographic-electronic system digitizes, stores and transmits referral images via dial-up phone lines within minutes -- much like computer data -- realizing dramatic time savings for radiologists.
