NEIGHBORS IN SPACE -- Crescent-shaped Earth and Moon are shown together for the first time in this photograph, recorded by the Voyager-1 spacecraft from a distance of 11.66 million kilometers. Eastern Asia, the Western Pacific Ocean and part of the Arctic are lighted. Because Earth is many times brighter than its satellite, program scientists at the Jet Propulsion Laboratory in California intensified the near image three times so that both bodies would show clearly in prints. Voyager-1, and its companion, Voyager-2, were launched last September and August. They are to arrive at Jupiter in 1979 and at Saturn a year or two later.
