

## FIFTH TIROS CONTINUES U.S. WEATHER SATELLITE RESEARCH PROGRAM

JAPAN VIEW -- This view of Hokkaido, Japan was taken from the Tiros V satellite during its 14th orbit around the earth. U.S. Weather Bureau scientists report that land areas appear dark in the picture due to sun glint on the Sea of Japan. The lower portion of the Island and Uchiura Bay are visible. The picture was received at the ground read-out station at Point Mugu, California. Tiros V was launched June 19 from Cape Canaveral, Florida.
