6. RANGER TARGETS — Drawing shows target areas scattered over the surface of the moon that have been photographed by Rangers 7, 8 and 9. Ranger 7 and 8 returned more than 11,000 close-ups of two of the moon's plains. Ranger 9 was the first to be sent into a crater it missed its target on Alphonsus by only 4 miles (6.4 kilometers). Ranger 9 is the last of the Ranger program; its goal to scout landing spots for astronauts. (65-1346)
