KENNEDY SPACE CENTER, Fla.—Orbiting Solar Observatory-1, scheduled for launch by KSC's Unmanned Launch Operations Directorate no earlier than June 20, is now undergoing final checkout at Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. In this operation, the sophisticated solar observatory is being weighed preparatory to being mated with its Delta rocket. OSO-1 will concentrate on studying the means by which energy is transmitted from the Sun's inner layers to the outer corona. *classif*
