SKYLAB 4 -- These Comet Kohoutek hydrogen halo far-ultraviolet (Lyman α) "growth" photos were taken from Skylab 4 with the S201 camera. Skylab 4 crew members Astronaut Gerald P. Carr, commander; Scientist-Astronaut Edward G. Gibson, science pilot; and Astronaut William R. Pogue, pilot, were launched from the Kennedy Space Center, Fla. on November 16, 1973. The crew splashed down in calm Pacific seas on February 8, 1974, 283 kilometers (176 statute miles) southwest of San Diego, Calif., at completion of the 84-day space station mission.
