

IMPACT ON THE MOON -- Drawing shows the spent third stage of the Apollo-13 rocket crashing on the Moon on April 14. The impact was some 140 kilometers west of the landing site of the Apollo-12 crew in the Ocean of Storms and tested the seismometer left there in November. At time of impact, the Apollo-13 astronauts were in their crippled spacecraft looping around the Moon on a premature return to Earth.
