



SMILING SPEEDSTERS -- Evelyn Ashford and Calvin Smith show their elation after setting new world records for the 100-meter dash within 15 minutes of each other at the National Sports Festival in Colorado Springs, Colorado. Ashford, 26, of Venice, California, covered the distance in 10.79 seconds to erase the women's mark of 10.81 set a month earlier by East German Marlies Goehr in East Berlin. Smith, a 22-year-old from Bolton, Mississippi, crossed the finish line in 9.93 seconds to wipe out the men's record of 9.95 set by Jim Hines of the United States at the 1968 Olympics in Mexico City. This was the first time the 100-meter records were broken in one day.
