AQUATIC STARS -- World records were broken by two American swimmers at the United States Olympic swimming trials at Indiana University in Indianapolis. John Moffet (left), 19, of Costa Mesa, California, swam the 100-meter breaststroke in 1 minute 2.13 seconds, bettering the previous mark of 1:02.20 set by American Steve Lundquist in August 1983. Pablo Morales (right), a 19-year-old Stanford University sophomore from Santa Clara, California, set a new record for the 100-meter butterfly. His time of 53.38 seconds eclipsed the old mark of 53.44 set by American Matt Gribble, also in August 1983. (84-2173)
