

WATER RECORDS -- The U.S. men's swimming team dominated the competition at the Montreal Olympics, winning 12 of 13 gold medals, 10 in world record times. Here Rod Strachan (left) races to a new world mark in the 400-meter individual medley and Brian Goodell does the same in the 400-meter freestyle event. Both athletes are from California. Strachan's time of 4 minutes 23.68 seconds eclipsed the old mark of 4:26.00 set earlier in 1976 by Zoltan Verraszato of Hungary. Goodell won in 3:51.93 to top his own world record of 3:53.08 set during the pre-Olympic trials.
