Two U.S. Olympic contestants, Russell Dermond, 20, of New Milford, New Jersey, in front, and John Pagkos, 19, of Yonkers, New York, in back, paddle their kayak in a practice session on the Hudson River in New York. They will be the U.S. competitors in the 1,000-meter tandem-kayak race in the 1956 Olympics at Melbourne. They qualified for the Games when they raced the same distance in the Olympic tryouts at Lake Sebago, New York, setting a new U.S. record of 4 minutes 5 seconds for the trials. (56-19869)
