NEW HOME FOR LIBERTY BELL -- With a record number of visitors expected in Philadelphia during this Bicentennial Year, one of America's most cherished and historic objects has been given a new home. The Liberty Bell has been moved from Independence Hall across the mall to a modern structure. It has long been a favorite attraction of tourists, many of whom are thrilled to touch its famous crack. The Bell was rung to announce the adoption of the Declaration of Independence in 1776 and was rung every successive anniversary until 1835, when it cracked while tolling the death of Chief Justice John Marshall.
