

MEMORIAL DEDICATED TO FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT

WARM SPRINGS, Georgia -- Here is the combination living-dining room of the Little White House, the late President Franklin D. Roosevelt was sitting in his favorite chair (center) when he was fatally stricken on April 12, 1945. Flanking the fireplace is the "Unfinished Portrait" on which Mrs. Elizabeth Shoumatoff was working at the time. The books in the lower part of the bookcase are just as they were at the time of his death. Those above are books about Mr. Roosevelt, most of them inscribed to the memorial by the authors.
