At his office in the White House in Machington, D.C. . President Harry 3. Trusan of the United States signs the document proclaiming the existence of a national emergency in the United States. The proplamation was issued because "recent events in Korsa and elsewhere constitute a grave throat to the peace of the world, and imperil the efforts of the United States and those of the United Nations to prevent aggression and areas conflict.

President Trumen declared that the military, navel, air, and civilian defenses of the Nation would be strangthened as speedily as possible. He called upon all citizens to see loval to the principles upon which our Nation is founded, to keep faith with our friends and allies, and to be fire in our devotion to the meaceful purnoses for which the United Matines was founded.
