BIRTHDAY WISHES -- President Ronald Reagan receives a card honoring his 74th birthday after completing his State of the Union address before a Joint Session of the Congress at the Capitol in Washington. Presenting the card is Senator Robert Kasten of Wisconsin. Behind them are Vice President George Bush (left) and Speaker of the House Thomas O'Neill. In his speech, Mr. Reagan called on the nation to forge "a second American revolution of hope and opportunity." He urged support for an agenda that ranged domestically from tax simplification and economic growth to "full and equal power" for minorities, and internationally from increased trade and construction of a permanent manned space station to the elimination of the threat of nuclear war.
