They were part of a line of nearly five million Americans who participated in "Hands Across America," a project organized to aid the country's hungry and homeless. The effort resulted in about \$28 million in donations and about \$9 million in pledges. Organizers said that people linked hands, with some major gaps for safety, along a line stretching from New York City on the East Coast to Long Beach, California on the West Coast.
