AMERICAN TOMB OF THE UNKNOWNIS ATTRACTS VISITORS FROM THROUGHOUT THE WORLD

MAY 22, 1961

This elevated view of the amphitheater at Arlington National Cemetery was made May 30, 1958, when funeral services were held for two unknowns who died fighting for the United States in World War II and in the Korean War. Their bodies were placed in the tomb beside the Unknown Soldier of World War I who had been brought to the United States from France in 1921.

Esta vista del anfiteatro del Cementerio Nacional de Arlington, fue tomada el 30 de mayo de 1958, cuando se celebraron servicios fúnebres en honor de dos norteamericanos desconocidos que murieron luchando por los Estados Unidos en la segunda guerra mundial y en la de Corea. Sus cuerpos fueron colocados en la Tumba junto al del Soldado Desconocido de la primera guerra mundial, que fue traído a los Estados Unidos desde Francia en 1921.
