Marking the site of the only major battle fought in the State of Florida during the War Between the States, the Olustee monument stands guard over five acres of pinelands along U. S. Highway 90 just east of Lake City, Florida. Today visitors can view the battleground with its old earthworks and relive the occasion when, many years ago, Federal troops endeavored to capture the Confederate supply base at Lake City in an attempt to isolate East from Central and West Florida.
