The University of Rhode Island has grown into a dynamic American institution of higher learning since it was established as a small agricultural college in 1888. Physical plant expansion in the past decade has included erection of many new structures and major remodeling operations on some of the older buildings.

Shown is the bell tower of Davis Hall, one of the original buildings on the 1400-acre campus at Kingston. Even the old bell in the tower has yielded to the age of electronics and has resumed its venerable task of calling students to classes by push-button controls.
