HISTORIC TABLE.....The Reverend Father German Ohueda, Prior of the Franciscan Monastery at La Rabida, Spain, which in 1492 sheltered Christopher Columbus before he sailed westward, tells how the explorer planned the expedition from this table to (left to right): U.S. Vice Consul (Seville) Anthony C. Albrecht Sr. Manuel Gonzalez Suarez, Secretary of the Royal (Spanish) Columbus Society; Peter P. Hayes, journalist third class, USN; and Commander Francis P. Adams, Chaplain Corps, USN. The group visited the monastery -- once site of a Roman temple and later a Moorish palace and mosque -- on October 12. Earlier in the day, U.S. Navy patrol aircraft dropped a wreath honoring Columbus in the channel from which his ships sailed. Chaplain Adams blessed the wreath. (Journalist Hayes is the son of Mr. and Mrs. William P. Hayes of 272 South Sixth st., Newark, N.J.)
