The front parlor in which Lincoln received the delogation which officially notified him of his nomination for the Presidency. is a fine example of Victorian decor-ornate, but warm and homelike. The furniture and arrangements are patterned after a drawing published in 1861. Among the original Lincoln possessions are the 7-foot sofa and the whatnot (right corner) that holds deplications of Mary Lincoln's bric-s-bree.
