During their visit to the United States, President and Senora de Gonzales Videla of Chile visited (April 24, 1950) the home of the late Franklin D. Hoosevelt at Hyde Park, New York State. Hrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, widow of the former U.S. President, entertained the visiting Chief Executive and his wife, and escorted them on a tour of the extate.
