

NEW MEMORIAL DEDICATED TO FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT

WARM SPRINGS, Georgia -- Simplicity is the keynote of this cottage that was the favorite home of the late President Franklin D. Roosevelt. Known as the Little White House because it was a substitute Executive Mansion on his many visits here during his presidency, the house and wooded grounds are maintained as they were when he lived and died there.
