THIS IS THE UNITED STATES-The Great Organ and the Temple which are located on the automobile road between Grand Gorge and Capitol Wash in Capitol Reef National Monument, in the State of Utah. This national monument preserves erosive formations—steep scarps, goñin rocks, carved pinnacles and gorges—and contains numerous archeological remains and petrified forests. The reef, which gives its name to the reservation, fits a definition, popularly used in Western United States, for an upthrust area with a cliff face. The great ridge of rock, twenty miles long, towers above its surroundings, buttressed with talus slopes. The area is rich in petrified and fossilized remains, and petrified wood fragments discovered there range from small twigs to 75-foot lengths, some five feet in diameter. On the cliff walls of the Monument are petroglyphs, representing sheep, snakes and human figures, carved by prehistoric Basketmaker and Pueblo peoples.

El Gran Organo y el Templo situados junto a la carretera entre Grand Gorge y Capitol Wash en el Monumento Nacional Capitol Reef, en el estado de Utah. Este monumento nacional conserva grandes formaciones creadas por la erosión, acantilados, desfiladeros, rocas fantasmagóricas, pináculos que parecen esculpidos, gargantas y precipicios, y contiene numerosos ~~vestigios~~ vestigios arqueológicos y bosques pterificados. En las rocas del monumento existen unas tallas representando ovejas, serpientes y figuras humanas, realizadas por pueblos prehistóricos.
