ECONOMICS RESEARCHER -- Gerard Debreu, 62, professor of economics and mathematics at the University of California in Berkeley, is recipient of the 1983 Nobel Memorial Prize in Economic Science. The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences praised him for his rigorous analysis of mathematical models underlying economic theories of supply and demand which lend themselves to "far reaching interpretations and applications." A native of France, Professor Debreu became a U.S. citizen in 1975. He joined the University in Berkeley in 1962. (83-2853)
