U.S. SCIENTISTS DISCOVER "BIRTH OF TORNADO" IN TIROS I SATELLITE PHOTO

TORNADO-PRODUCING CLOUD MASS -- The almost square mass of clouds at lower right was traced by U.S. Weather Bureau scientists as source of tornadoes over Oklahoma. Photograph was made by Tiros I, the experimental weather satellite, over Texas-Oklahoma border. Surface weather observations showed cloud mass, composed of large cumulo-nimbus clouds, later moved north-eastward spawning tornadoes and hail. (60-4520)
