LUNAR ROCK -- This is another view of the 45-centimeter-long lunar rock (right center) lying about 3.5 meters from Surveyor I on the surface of the moon. The picture was received June 6 during the spacecraft's fifth day of operation. The horizon is visible at upper left and at right is part of the spacecraft's omnidirectional antenna latch. This is a 600-line photo taken through the 25-degree wide angle lens. Surveyor I was launched May 31 from Cape Kennedy in Florida and made a "soft" landing on the moon June 2. (66-1828)
