The Viking spacecraft will be carrying these three emblems when it touches down on the surface Mars about July 4, 1976. They are the American flag, the United States Bicentennial symbol (center), and the winning emblem designed by American student Peter Puroi of Baltimore, Md., in the National Viking Student Emblem Contest. The Viking lander's camera's are expected to photograph the three logos as panoramic views of the Martian surface are sent back to Earth.
