"TUNNEL WITH 3000-MILE WINDS
WILL TEST U.S. SPACESHIPS"

3-5 This huge device, which serves a function similar to the radiator of an automobile, cools the 3000-mile-per-hour wind as it races through the tunnel toward the section where space vehicles will be tested. More than 54,000 gallons of water per minute are pumped through the baffles in this grille to cool the high-speed airflow. (59-22423) (See also accompanying text)
