Carr, commonder; Scientist-Astronaut Edward G. Gibson, science pilot; and Astronaut William R. Fogus, pilot, were issuached from the Kennedy Space Conter. Fls. on Hovember 16, 1973. The crew spisshed down in calm Pacific seas on February 8, 1974, 283 kilometers (176 statute miles) southwest of San Diego, Calif., at completion of the 84-day space station mission.
