

SPECTACULAR ARRAY -- Saturn's C-ring and part of the B-ring (upper left) highlight this Voyager 2 view from 2.7 million kilometers. More than 60 bright and dark ringlets are visible. Shading variations are believed caused by differing composition of the materials in the complex structures. Three tiny ringlets in the B-ring are similar in hue to the B-ring (yellow-brown in the false color image). The second Voyager discovered many more rings around the planet than appeared in the earlier spacecraft and telescope pictures.
