

3-15 In 1963, the United States will conduct tests of the Gemini capsule, designed to accommodate two men. This capsule, the follow-up of the one-man Mercury capsule, is intended for long flights far out in space. Before astronauts fly in Gemini, the capsule will undergo many unmanned tests, during which it will rendezvous in orbit with a rocket launched separately. (62-1585)
