

GRADUATING INTO THE RECORD BOOK -- Bruce Furniss, 18, of Santa Ana, California, has triple reason to smile. During the same week in June, he graduated from high school and twice broke the world record for the 200-meter freestyle swimming event. Competing at nearby Long Beach in the U.S. trials for the world swimming championships, he covered the distance in 1 minute 51.41 seconds and later the same day topped his own mark with a time of 1:50.89. The old record of 1:51.66 was set in 1974 by Long Beach Swim Club teammate Tim Shaw.
