Duke Paoa Kahanamoku, member of the United States swimming team, received his trophy from King Albert I of Belgium after winning the 100-meter free style event at the Olympic Games of 1920 held in Antwerp. Previously, Duke set records for eight years with his speedy stroke, a crawl which he had learned by watching older Hawaiian swimmers in his homeland. Now 66 years old, Kahanamoku is regarded as Hawaii's unofficial ambassador to the world. For more than 20 years he has been continuously elected Sheriff of the City and County of Honolulu.
