## U.S. OLYMPIC SOCCER PARTICIPANTS

Thirty-four of the United States top amateur soccer players recently battled for 15 places on the 1956 U.S. Olympic soccer team in a hard fought game at St. Louis. With the participants divided into teams from the East and West, the game ended in a 1-1 tie.
