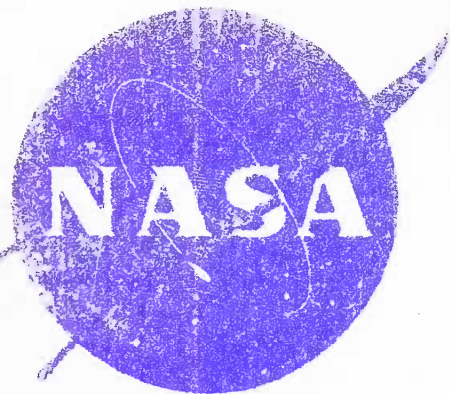

APOLLO 11 -- EARTH VIEW -- This view of the rising Earth greeted the Apollo 11 astronauts as they came from behind the Moon after the lunar orbit insertion burn. Earth is just above the lunar horizon in this photograph. The uncannily smooth surface features in the foreground are near the eastern limb of the Moon as viewed from Earth. Earth is 240,000 statute miles away.
